3 Matters Arising (not covered elsewhere on the agenda - for information only)

3.1 <u>Update on Kingsway Green Posts</u>

The contractor has reviewed the plan of underground services and has confirmed that installation of the posts should take place on either Tuesday 25 February or Wednesday 26 February.

3.2 <u>Update on Farnham Common Village Sign</u>

The sign was initially recovered by Rebecca Brennan, a resident, and the Parish Council would like to thank her for her action. The sign is now being stored by Capability Landscapes Limited. On inspection it became apparent that the paintwork needed to be retouched. One quote has been received and another has been requested. Capability Landscapes Limited will then reinstall the sign on the Green. It has been suggested, however, that a different location on the Green may be more suitable.

Given that the sign in Farnham Royal was crafted in the same way and installed at the same time it may be sensible to check whether any work is needed here.

3.3 Update on the wild flower verge pilot scheme

At the last meeting, the Parish Council agreed to conduct a flower verge pilot along the A355 just south of Elm Close. Since the meeting, one of the residents who proposed the scheme has expressed concern that the contractor may not use the specific seed mix identified by them, Pictorial Meadow Mix, preferring their usual mix called Rainbow Annual. At the request of the Chairman, the Clerk has asked Dr Helen Read of Burnham Beeches SAC and our contractor for the pros and cons associated with each seed mix.
